YOUTH REPRESENTATIVE

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Serve a 2-year term as a voting member on the Department Advisory Committee (DAC)

Terms shall be from October 1 to September 30 of each year

Serve as an ambassador of the Upper Peninsula State Fair (UPSF)

Represent all junior exhibitors and voice the concerns of those exhibitors

Provide a youth voice and input concerning policies and procedures developed by the committee to determine if they are in the best interests of UPSF youth exhibitors

Be familiar with rules and regulations as listed in the UPSF Exhibitor's Guide to Classes and Awards

Make a best effort to stay informed and attend all scheduled DAC meetings.

Submit ideas to the DAC for new programs and activities

QUALIFICATIONS:

Submit a letter of interest to the DAC chairperson

Provide a letter of recommendation from:

-a UPSF Representative (ex. Department Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, Department Representative, DAC member, UPSF management, UPSF Authority member)

-Teacher, School Official or Coach

-Club leader or 4-H Educator

Minimum age of 16

Have experience in exhibiting and be a current UPSF junior exhibitor

Possess the ability to work with adults and other youth in a variety of situations

Possess the ability to work and communicate effectively

Have a willingness to become familiar with and work within the philosophy of the UPSF

REPRESENTATIVE

RESPONSIBILITIES:

There are no term limits

Representatives must be re-nominated and re-elected every two (2) years

Department representatives will be nominated by exhibitors of that department and chosen by the DAC.

Terms shall be from October 1 to September 30 of each year

Serve as an ambassador of the Upper Peninsula State Fair (UPSF)

Represent all exhibitors and voice the concerns of those exhibitors

Provide a voice and input concerning policies and procedures developed by the committee to determine if they are in the best interests of UPSF exhibitors

Be familiar with rules and regulations as listed in the UPSF Exhibitor's Guide to Classes and Awards

Make a best effort to stay informed and attend all scheduled DAC meetings. Attend the 2 required DAC meetings in August and October

Submit ideas to the DAC for new programs and activities

Work with and assist the Department Superintendent as needed
